

BARANGUBA (MONTAGUE ISLAND)

Is the second largest island off NSW and is one of the most certified conservation areas in the world.

The historic boat sheds are painted different colours and are one of Narooma's most photographed sites.




GULAGA (MOUNT DROMEDARY)

Gulaga (Mount Dromedary) otherwise know as the Mother Mountain is sacred to the local Yuin people.



HISTORICAL CENTRAL TILBA

This National Trust protected Village was originally settled by gold prospectors in the late 1890's.



The hole in the rock is in the shape of the map of Australia hence the name Australia Rock.



A great place to view the stunning coastline north towards Kianga and Dalmeny.



Look out for the seal colony on the left hand side of the breakwall. Please remember to keep your distance.



Located just south of Narooma, Glasshouse Rocks are a unique geographical rock formation.



HISTORIC CEMETERY

This cemetery is the resting place of the original families who settled in the area.
